Bensinger's gig

Graham Bensinger, who graduated from Country Day last spring, then a few months later had the most high-impact interview of the year in sports, is getting his own national radio show. Bensinger, who recently completed his freshman year at Syracuse University, has been hired by Sirius Satellite Radio to conduct a sports show from 9 a.m.-noon Saturdays on Channel 123. It begins today.

Bensinger, now 19, made the big time last fall, when Philadelphia receiver Terrell Owens told him in an interview that he agreed with the idea that the Eagles, who were 4-3 then, would be undefeated if Green Bay's Brett Favre were their quarterback instead of Donovan McNabb. That comment was the final straw in a long soap opera between the team and player, and Owens soon thereafter was suspended, then dumped.
